

Marine Spatial Planning (MSP) is a public process of analyzing and allocating the spatial and temporal distribution of human activities in marine areas to achieve ecological, economic and social objectives that have been specified through a political process.

European Union (EU) Outermost Regions (ORs) of the Azores (Portugal), Madeira (Portugal), Canary Islands (Spain) and French Guiana (France), with the support of their Member States national authorities, joined cooperative efforts to support the implementation of the European Maritime Spatial Planning Directive (MSP Directive 2014/89/EU) to advance their Maritime Spatial Planning (MSP) implementation processes.
